Overnighting of Policies and Manual Notification Receipt E-Mails

Sign up for ePolicy Delivery and Automated Requirement E-Mails!

The following changes are going into effect in June:

As of June 1, 2010, the home office will no longer overnight Term and Accident & Health (A&H) policies to producers. After June 1, producers will receive their Term and A&H policies via USPS first class mail.

We encourage you to sign up for ePolicy Delivery, a faster, environmentally friendly alternative to sending hard copies of policies through the mail.

ePolicy Delivery is the electronic delivery of policy print for Term and Accident & Health products through the eStation Web site. Get set up today; e-mail your request to eSubmission.requests@aglife.com. Our team will respond promptly to get you set up and explain your options.

Also on June 1, 2010, we will discontinue sending e-mails manually to our producers when we have received the new application in the home office.

We implemented Automated Requirement e-mails in 2009. This system automatically sends e-mail notification, informing of any updates to the policy, to the e-mail addresses you have registered on the eStation Web site.

Stay up-to-date on your policies by registering on the producer Web site, eStation.aglife.com, to access Automated Requirement e-mails.

By utilizing Automated Requirement e-mails and ePolicy delivery, you can increase speed-to-issue on your policies so it's faster than ever before!
